

## Music PAL Access Card

The Music PAL Access Card tells the library you are visiting that you are a genuine learner and that your special requirements for information or knowledge cannot be dealt with by your own library. Before getting a Music PAL Access Card your librarian will ask you a few questions to find out what you are looking for and will then advise you about which libraries have the information you need. Remember - the library you will be visiting is looking after its own members and may not be able to offer all of its services to you, such as use of their PCs and networks. Please ask, but also understand if they decline to provide you with everything you need during your visit. You may also be asked to provide additional personal ID.

## Guidelines for Music PAL Visitors

- To qualify for a Music PAL Access Card you must be a current member of one of the libraries participating in the scheme.
- Music PAL Access Card holders must abide by the regulations of the particular library they are visiting and whose facilities they are using.
- Music PAL Access Card holders should take some additional ID (e.g. driving licence or utility bill) with them as well as their Music PAL Access Card when visiting a participating library.
- Your Music PAL Access Card will expire one year after the date of issue.
- Music PAL Access Card holders are advised to contact the library they intend to visit in advance to ensure that the material they hope to use is currently available.
- Music PAL Access Card holders are advised to check the opening hours of the library they intend to visit.
- When you visit another library you must show your Music PAL Access Card before using its facilities.
- The Music PAL Access Card covers only the named person and will allow them access only to the libraries participating in the scheme.
